

Intermediate Painting: Paint Application and Color

MATERIALS LIST

If you are going to use a solvent it MUST be Gamblin's *Gamsol*. This product is far less toxic than typical paint thinners, turpentines, etc.

The list below is not required, only recommended. If you already have oil paint supplies you can use what you have.

PAINTS:

- 150-200 ml tube
 - Titanium white
- 37-40 ml tubes
 - Cadmium Yellow (Medium if Gamblin oil)
 - Hansa Yellow Light
 - Cadmium Red (or Bright Red, cheaper)
 - Alizarin Crimson
 - French Ultramarine
 - Cerulean

OTHER MATERIALS:

- Gamsol
- Silicoil brush cleaner tank (for Gamsol)
- small jar of linseed oil
- palette
- canvases (for size, I recommend small to medium canvases, no canvases larger than 30")
- metal palette knife
- paper towels or painting rags
- 1 small sealable jar/container for painting medium
- brushes
- a small sketchbook, pencil/pen
