Warm yellow: eg new gamboge (WN) or permanent yellow deep (DS),indian yellow (MG), Cool yellow: eg. Winsor yellow (WN), Hansa yellow light (DS), Azo yellow (DS) warm red: eg. Pyrrol scarlet (DS) permanent red (Daler Rowney), Cad red light HUE Cool red: eg. Permanent rose (WN), Quinacridone rose (DS) or magenta. (any brand) Warm blue: eg. French Ultramarine blue,

Cool blue: eg. Phthalo blue (green shade), prussian blue

** Neutral tint, eg. DS or WN-has a 5ml tube available.

** Burnt sienna any brand, I use Holbein brand.
